Awareness of How Claims Can Arise

DRUG AND DEVICE CLAIMS

Mirena is an IUD that was approved as an intrauterine contraceptive and later approved as a treatment for heavy menstrual bleeding. Serious adverse side effects and potentially life-threatening complications have been reported following implantation of the device. Complications include organ perforation, migration of the IUD to outside the uterus, and expulsion of the IUD, and embedment in the uterus.

Risperdal, an atypical antipsychotic drug, used to treat schizophrenia and certain problems caused by bipolar. Risperdal has been linked to the development of gynecomastia, a condition that causes male breast growth, in boys and young men.

Viagra has had a preliminary study showing that men, who have taken this drug, have an increased risk of developing melanoma, the deadliest form of skin cancer. Men, who used Viagra at some point in their life, have about double the risk of development of melanoma, and men currently taking Viagra have an 84% greater risk.

Lipitor, a statin drug to treat high cholesterol, has recent studies that have found a possible link between Lipitor and developing Type 2 diabetes in postmenopausal women.

PRODUCT LIABILITY CLAIMS

Worker's Compensation Claims often times are more than that.
