#### **Pecan Cobbler**

1 1/2 cups Brown Sugar

1/2 Cup of Butter

1 pkg White Cake Mix

1 Cup Pecans

1 3/4 cups Hot Water

Preheat oven to 350. In a 9x13 pan melt butter in oven, then spread pecans over butter. Spread dry cake mix evenly over pecans (do not stir), spread brown sugar over cake mix, pour hot water over mixture, do not stir. Bake 25-30 minutes - serve with Ice Cream.

#### Easy Cheese Ball

2 (8-oz) pkgs. cream cheese, softened

1/4 cup mayonnaise

1/3 cup grated parmesan cheese

½ cup cheddar cheese

1/4 cup chopped green onions

½ tsp. Worcestershire sauce

1/4 tsp. garlic powder

1 cup sliced almonds, chopped

- 1. Combine cream cheese and mayonnaise until smooth.
- 2. Add in parmesan cheese, cheddar cheese, green onions, Worcestershire sauce and garlic powder. Stir together until combined.
- 3. Pour chopped almonds onto plastic wrap and then roll cheese ball in almonds. Roll up into plastic wrap and refrigerate.
- Unwrap and place on a plate. Serve with crackers and devour. Enjoy!

### Claims that Could Affect You

**Testosterone Replacement Therapy (TRT)** products for men have been linked to an increased risk of death, heart attack, stroke, or death after three years of use. A second study found that men had a significant increase in risk of heart attack and stroke in just the first 90 days of testosterone therapy use.

**Fosamax** – manufactured by Merck, is in a class of drugs called bisphosphonates. Fosamax is commonly used in tablet form to prevent and treat osteoporosis in post-menopausal women. Fosamax has been linked to low-energy femur fractures in people taking Fosamax for three or more years.

**Metal on Metal Hip Replacements –** hip replacement manufacturers have been under heavy scrutiny over the past few years regarding the dangers of their metal on metal hip devices. The main hip devices under scrutiny are:

- Johnson & Johnson/DePuy: ASR Total Hip Replacement and ASR Resurfacing System hip
- Johnson & Johnson: Pinnacle metal on metal hip
- · Zimmer: Durom Cup hip
- · Stryker: Rejuvenate and ABG II Stems
- Biomet: M2a and 30 Diameter hips
- Wright: (a) Conserve, (b) Dynasty, (c) Lineage and (d) Profemus hips; and
- Smith & Nephew: R3 Liner hips

Metal on Metal hip patients' problems include pain, swelling, and problems walking. This can result in a revision surgery. Also, metal debris spreading in the hip area has been reported.
